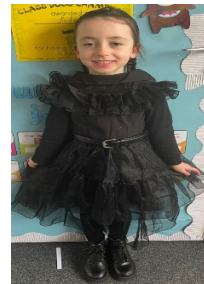

They learnt all about how books are organised and how we can borrow books from the library. They had a presentation about the different genre styles available and had the opportunity to choose our favourite book.

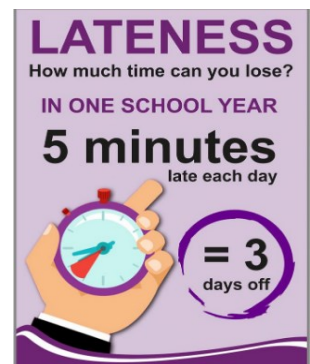
